RULES OF WRITING WORKS PROPOSED FOR THE COLLECTIONS PUBLISHED BY THE INSTITUTE OF CULTURAL HERITAGE

I. Name of the author and title of the article: text-centric, simple: Surname and name of the author (s); new line, text-centered, bold: title of the article).

II. Summary:

Summary in English accompanied by 5-6 keywords. The summary shall be between 1,000–1,200 characters, including spaces and punctuation marks (Times New Roman, Font size: 10, Space: 1.0)

III. Text of the paper:

The size of the text will be 0.4-0.5 author's pages (5-6 pages, 16,000–20,000 characters, including spaces and punctuation marks), including bibliography and illustrative material. The text of the papers must be submitted in electronic format: Times New Roman, Font size: 12, Space: 1.5. (left 25 mm, top, bottom, right - 15 mm)

IV. Notes: The notes are placed at the end of the main text. As in the text, the numbering of the notes is done with superscript (for example ⁵).

V. List of informants: includes name, age, locality.

VI. List of abbreviations

VII. Bibliography references:

The bibliography will be placed after the main text of the article and the notes. The links shall be arranged alphabetically. References to bibliographic sources shall be indicated in **round** brackets, inserted in the text, for example:

Monograph: (Eliade 1994: 45), i.e.: a) the name of the author, b) the year of publication, c) colon: d) no. of the page to which the author refers. If necessary, it will be continued by indicating the number of the image, table or map, i.e. (Eliade 1994: 45, img. 5, tab. 8).

Article in a Journal: (Ceașescu 2018: 204), i.e.: a) the name of the author, b) the year of the edition of the paper, c) colon: d) no. of the page to which the author refers.

Article in collection: (Livadă-Cadeschi 2005: 11), i.e.: a) the name of the author, b) the year of publication of the paper, c) colon: d) no. of the page to which the author refers.

Archive document: (F., inv., d., f.), i.e.: a) the name of the archive, b) the fund number, c) the inventory number, d) the folder number, e) the file number to which the author refers .

Electronic document: (Antonescu 2009).

In the case of works without an author, the first word is indicated (in the case of a word of up to 3 letters, the first two words are indicated, then the year and the page (Cartea 2020: 6)

Examples of sources published in References:

Monograph: Eliade M. Imagini și simboluri. București: Editura Humanitas, 1994. 223 p. That is, the following will be indicated (in the established order): a) the name of the author (s), b) the initials of the author (s), c) the name of the work, d) the place of publication, e) the publishing house year of publication, g) total number of pages.

Article in Journal: Ceașescu A. Câteva considerații privind simbolistica fierului în obiceiurile familiale din Oltenia. In: Arhivele Olteniei, 2018, nr. 32, p. 201-210. Indicate: a) the name of the author (s), b) the initials of the author (s), c) the title of the paper, d) the dividing symbol **In:**, e) the name of the journal, f) the year of publication of the journal, g) the number of the journal, h) first and last page of the article.

Article in a collection: Livadă-Cadeschi L. Un mariage décidé en instance: du concubinage au mariage en Valachie à la fin du XVIII-ème siècle. In: Bonnes et mauvaises moeurs dans la société roumaine d'hier et d'aujourd'hui, I. Bă-luță, C. Vintilă-Ghițulescu (coord.). București: NEC, 2005, p. 111-18. Indicate: a) the name of the author (s), b) the initials of the author (s), c) the title of the article, d) the dividing symbol **In:**, e) the title of the collection, f) Coordinators if any, g) place, publisher and year of publication of the collection, g) first and last page of the article.

Archive document: AȘ AȘM: Arhiva Științifică a Academiei de Științe a Moldovei AS Fund, inventory, folder, file.

Electronic documents: Antonescu R. Dicționar de Simboluri și Credințe Tradiționale Românești. 2009. 729 p. – <http://cimec.ro/Etnografie/Antonescu-dictionar/Antonescu-Romulus-Dictionar-Simboluri-Credinte-Traditionale-Romanesti.pdf> (accessed 04.03.2020).

VIII. Illustrative material:

The illustrative material shall be presented in clear graphic form in electronic format (JPG or TIF: not less than 300 dpi). Images, tables, graphs, etc. shall be accompanied by the corresponding legends and the reference to the source of origin.

IX. Data on the author:

Surname, name, scientific-didactic degree, position, institution, e-mail, ORCID.
