To register, please complete the participation form (see **Appendix**) and send the abstract of the communication (maximum 3000 characters with spaces) to the address corresponding to the thematic area, by August 15, 2026.

The abstract must be written in one of the working languages of the conference: Romanian, English, Ukrainian or another international language. The title of the paper will be presented both in the original language and in English, accompanied by 5 keywords. Text format: *Times New Roman, size 12, spacing 1.5; margins: left 25 mm, top/bottom/right 15 mm.*

Each participant can submit only one paper, which may have co-authors, depending on the specifics of the topic addressed.

The conference is held within the framework of the Research Program 170101, dedicated to the study of the „Built, ethnographic, archaeological and artistic cultural heritage of the Republic of Moldova in the context of European integration”.

Transportation and accommodation costs are the responsibility of the participants.

The full conference program and the volume with the abstracts of the papers will be distributed on the day of the event.
